ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 7-2-5 AND 7-2-7 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF MT. AUBURN

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. AUBURN, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: Section 7-2-5 of the Village Code of Mt. Auburn is hereby amended as follows:

- 7-2-5 <u>CLASSIFICATION FEE.</u> There shall be five classes of liquor licenses that shall be referred to as:
- (A) Class "A" licenses which shall authorize the retail sale on the premises specified of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises as well as other retail sales of such liquor. The annual fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

- (B) <u>Class "B"</u> licenses which shall authorize the retail sale of beer and wine only and for consumption on the premises where sold. The annual fee for such license shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
- (C) <u>Class "C"</u> license issued pursuant to this classification shall permit the sale of beer and or wine only. This license shall be issued for periods not to exceed a period of seventy-two hours as specifically set forth in the permit issued. This license shall be issued only to duly certified non-profit organizations free of license fee or other administrative charge, provided however, the licensee shall furnish satisfactory proof of purchase of dram shop insurance and public liability and property damage insurance to provide for indemnification due to death, personal injuries, property damages and loss of means of support as appropriate in amounts not less than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) with respect to one individual and Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) with respect to one occurrence, and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for property damage.
- (D) <u>Class "D"</u> Notwithstanding anything in this Code to the contrary, the corporate authorities, in their sole discretion, may issue Class "D" licenses from time to time for special events. Such licenses shall permit the delivery and/or giving and/or sale of alcoholic liquor or spirits and/or wine and/or beer for consumption on, about or off the premises where delivered and/or given and/or sold, all as may be determined by the

majority vote of the corporate authorities. The terms of, fee for, and duration of license, and such other conditions the corporate authorities may impose on such license, shall be as determined by the majority vote of the corporate authorities.

(E) <u>Class "E"</u> license which shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption only off the licensed premises where sold. The annual fee for such license shall be <u>three hundred</u> Dollars (\$ 300.000). annually 1.55.

Section 2: The first sentence of Section 7-2-7 of the Village Code of Mt. Auburn is hereby amended, which shall now read as follows:

7-2-7 LIMITATION OF LICENSES.

There shall be allowed only two Class A, one Class B, and one Class E liquor licenses within the Village.

Section 3: That if any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect or otherwise impair any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance which is not, in or of itself, invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4: That the provisions of other Village of Mt. Auburn Ordinances, to the extent they duplicate, conflict with or otherwise affect the validity hereof, shall be disregarded.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
