STATE OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Auburn in the County of Christian and the State of Illinois, did on the 7th day of December, 2009, pass the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of said Village for the Fiscal Year commencing May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$1,071,820.00, which said Annual Appropriation Ordinance was duly published in pamphlet form on the 7th day of December, 2009; and

WHEREAS, more than 20 days prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, the President and Board of Trustees of the village of Mt. Auburn, Christian County, Illinois, did on the 7th day of December, 2009, pass a Motion wherein they determined the amounts of money, exclusive of any portion of this levy attributed to the cost of conducting an election required by the general election law, estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the aforesaid fiscal year upon the taxable property on its district, all in compliance with Section 4 of Public Act 82-102 known as the Truth in Taxation Act; and it has been determined that no public hearing is required pursuant to said "Truth in Taxation Act" incident to the adoption of this Tax Levy Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and the board of Trustees of the village of Mt. Auburn, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the total amount of \$23,000.00 be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of said Village of Mt. Auburn according to the value of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for a state and county purposes for the current fiscal year for the following more specific purposes and funds mentioned in said Annual Appropriations Ordinance and including herein, and in the respective specific amounts, as follows, to-wit:
