WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Auburn in the Village of Mt. Auburn, County of Christian, State of Illinois, have passed an ordinance amending the position of Village Clerk from an "Elected" position to an "appointed" position and to amend the language of the position to be gender neutral..

WHEREAS, the Village of Mt. Auburn, Illinois has the authority, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/3.1-25-90 to pass a resolution amending the Village Clerk's position from an "elected" position to an "appointed" position.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. AUBURN, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Section 1-2-48 of DIVISION VI-VILLAGE CLERK, is amended to read as follows:

1-2-48 - APPOINTED. The Village Clerk shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the concurrence of the Village Board, for a one year term on the first day of May of each year.

SECTION 2. That Section 1-2-57 of DIVISION VI-VILLAGE CLERK, is amended to read as follows:

1-2-57: SUCCESSOR. The Village Clerk shall carefully preserve in his or her office, all books, records, papers, maps and effects of every detail and description belonging to the Village or pertaining to his or her office, and not in actual use and possession of other Village officers; and upon the expiration of his or her official term, he or she shall deliver all such books, records, papers, and effects to his or her successor in office.

SECTION 3: The original Ordinance on page 23, of the ordinance book has been marked amended. It states "Amended by Ordinance 126 changing the position to an appointed position". The Original Ordinance on page 24, was also marked amended. It states "Amended by Ordinance 126 making the terms gender neutral."

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
