WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Auburn in the Village of Mt. Auburn, County of Christian, State of Illinois, did on the 5th day of July 2011, pass, the annual Appropriation Ordinance of said Village for the Fiscal year beginning May 1, 2011 and ending April 30, 2012, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of \$1,191,950.00 which said Annual Appropriation Ordinance was duly published in pamphlet form on the 5th day of July 2011; and

WHEREAS, more than twenty (20) days prior to the adoption of this Ordinance, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Auburn, Christian County, Illinois did on the 6th day of December 2011, pass a Motion wherein they determined the amounts or money, exclusive of any portion of this levy attributed to the cost of conducting an election required by the general election law, estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the aforesaid Fiscal Year upon the taxable property in its district, all in compliance with Section 4 of Public Act 82-102 known as the Truth in Taxation Act; and it has been determined that no public hearing is required pursuant to said "Truth in Taxation Act" incident to the adoption of this Tax Levy Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mt. Auburn, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the total amount of \$23,300.00 be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon all property subject to taxation within the corporation limits of said Village of Mt. Auburn according to value of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current Fiscal Year for the following more specific purposes sand funds mentioned in said Annual Appropriation Ordinance and including herein, and in the respective specific amounts, as follows, to wit:
