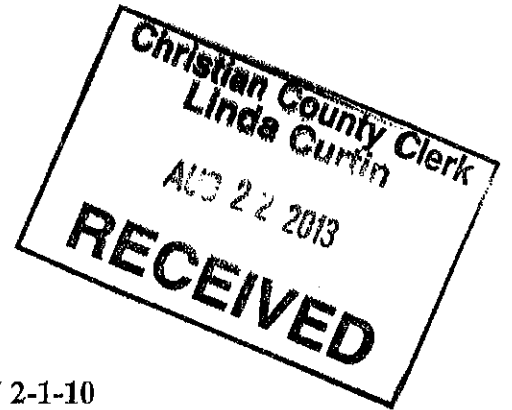

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-1-10
OF THE MT. AUBURN VILLAGE CODE
(RE: Dogs Prohibited from Running Loose)**

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. AUBURN, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 2-1-10 was previously amended in Ordinance #137. This Ordinance supersedes Ordinance #137. Section 2-1-10 of the Mt. Auburn Village Code is hereby amended and shall now read as follows:

A. Running at Large Prohibited: It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and unlawful for any dog to run at large at any time within the corporate limits of the Village of Mt. Auburn. The owner or keeper of any dog that runs at large within the Village limits shall be in violation of this Section 2-1-10 and is subject to a penalty as herein provided.

B. Leash Required: It is unlawful for any dog to leave the premises of its owner or keeper when not under control by leash or other recognized control methods. The owner or keeper of such dog that leaves the premises of its owner or keeper when not under control by leash or other recognized control methods shall be in violation of this Section 2-1-10 and is subject to a penalty as herein provided.

C. Penalties: any owner or keeper of a dog in violation of this Section 2-1-10 shall be given a written warning for the first violation and shall be fined as follows for each violation thereafter:

- (1) \$50.00 for the Second violation and then increased to \$150.00 if not paid in 30 days plus court costs if any;
- (2) \$100.00 for the third violation and then increased to \$200.00 if not paid in 30 day plus court costs if any;
- (3) \$150.00 for the fourth violation and then increased to \$300.00 if not paid in 30 days plus court costs if any;
- (4) \$150.00 for each violation thereafter as outlined in paragraph 3 above, which occurs within a twelve month consecutive time period after the fourth violation.

[D.] Current Rabies Shot: All dogs must have current on their Rabies vaccinations. Any owner or keeper of a dog in violation of paragraph D. Shall be fined \$50.00 and then increased to \$150.00 if not paid in 30 days plus court costs if any.

E. All fines shall be paid by mail or in person to the Village Clerk on or before the designated date given on the citation and checks shall be made payable to the Village of Mt. Auburn. If the offender fails to pay the fine to the Village Clerk as required, the Village may file a Complaint for Violation of Ordinance in a Court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 2: If any section, clause provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be in valid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect or otherwise impair any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance which is not, in or of itself, invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: EFFECT DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
