CANNABIS CONTROL ORDINANCE

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. AUBURN, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS the Village Code has the authority to enact a local Cannabis Control Ordinance.

SECTION 1: **ACT:** Unless authorized by the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act (410 ILCS 130/1 *et Seq.*); the Illinois Cannabis Control Act or equivalent State of Illinois or federal statute decriminalizing the use of Cannabis, it is unlawful for any person knowingly to possess not more than 10 grams of any substance containing cannabis within the Village of Mt. Auburn.

SECTION 2: **DEFINITION:** (a) "Cannabis" includes marijuana, hashish and other substances which are identified as including any parts of the plant Cannabis Sativa, whether growing or not; the seeds thereof, the resin extracted from any part of such plant; and any compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of such plant, its seeds, or resin, including tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and all other cannabino derivatives, including its naturally occurring or synthetically produced ingredients, whether produced directly or indirectly by extraction, or independently by means of chemical synthesis or by a combination of extraction and chemical synthesis; but shall not include the mature stalks of such plant, fiber produced from such stalks, oil or cake made from the seeds of such plant, any other compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of such mature stalks (except the resin extracted therefrom), fiber, oil or cake, or the sterilized seed of such plant which is incapable of germination.

SECTION 3: **FINES:** Any person violating this Act shall be a civil fine as determined by the following schedule:

- A. Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per offense:

SECTION 4: If any term, paragraph, clause, condition or provision of this Statute is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of the provisions here of, shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired or invalidated thereby, and this ordinance shall be construed in all respects as if such invalid, void or unenforceable provision were omitted.

SECTION 5: **EFFECT DATE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
