AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 1
OF MT. AUBURN VILLAGE CODE
(Re: Salaries)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD
OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MT. AUBURN, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Article III of Chapter 1 of the Mt. Auburn Village Code is hereby amended
and shall now read as follows:

CHAPTER 1

ADMINISTRATION

ARTICLE III – SALARIES

A. MAYOR: Commencing with the term of office of the Mayor (i.e. Village President)
to be elected in 2005 and to be elected thereafter, the Mayor shall receive as salary the sum
of One Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$172.00) per month.

B. VILLAGE CLERK: Commencing with the term of office of the Village Clerk to be
elected in 2005 and to be elected thereafter, the Village Clerk shall receive as salary the sum
of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per month.

C. VILLAGE TREASURER: Commencing with the term of office of the Village
Treasurer to be appointed in 2005 and to be appointed thereafter, the Village Treasurer shall
receive a salary of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per month.

D. VILLAGE TRUSTEES: Commencing with the terms of office of each Village
Trustee to be elected in 2005 and for terms of office of each trustee to be elected thereafter,
each of such Trustees shall receive as salary the sum of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) per month.

E. SPECIAL MEETINGS: Commencing with the terms of office to be elected in 2005
and for terms of office to be elected thereafter, the Mayor, Clerk, Village Treasurer, and

Trustees shall each receive an additional Twenty Dollars for each special Village Board of Trustee's meeting they attend.

F. COMMITTEE MEETINGS: Commencing with the terms of office to be elected in 2005 and for terms of office to be elected thereafter, ~~the Mayor, Clerk, and Trustees~~ *all occupied city mainlers* shall each receive an additional Twenty Dollars for each Village committee meeting they attend.

Section 2: That if any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect or otherwise impair any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance which is not, in or of itself, invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3: That other provisions of the Mt. Auburn Village Code or other Ordinances, to the extent they duplicate, conflict with or otherwise affect the validity hereof, shall be disregarded.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
